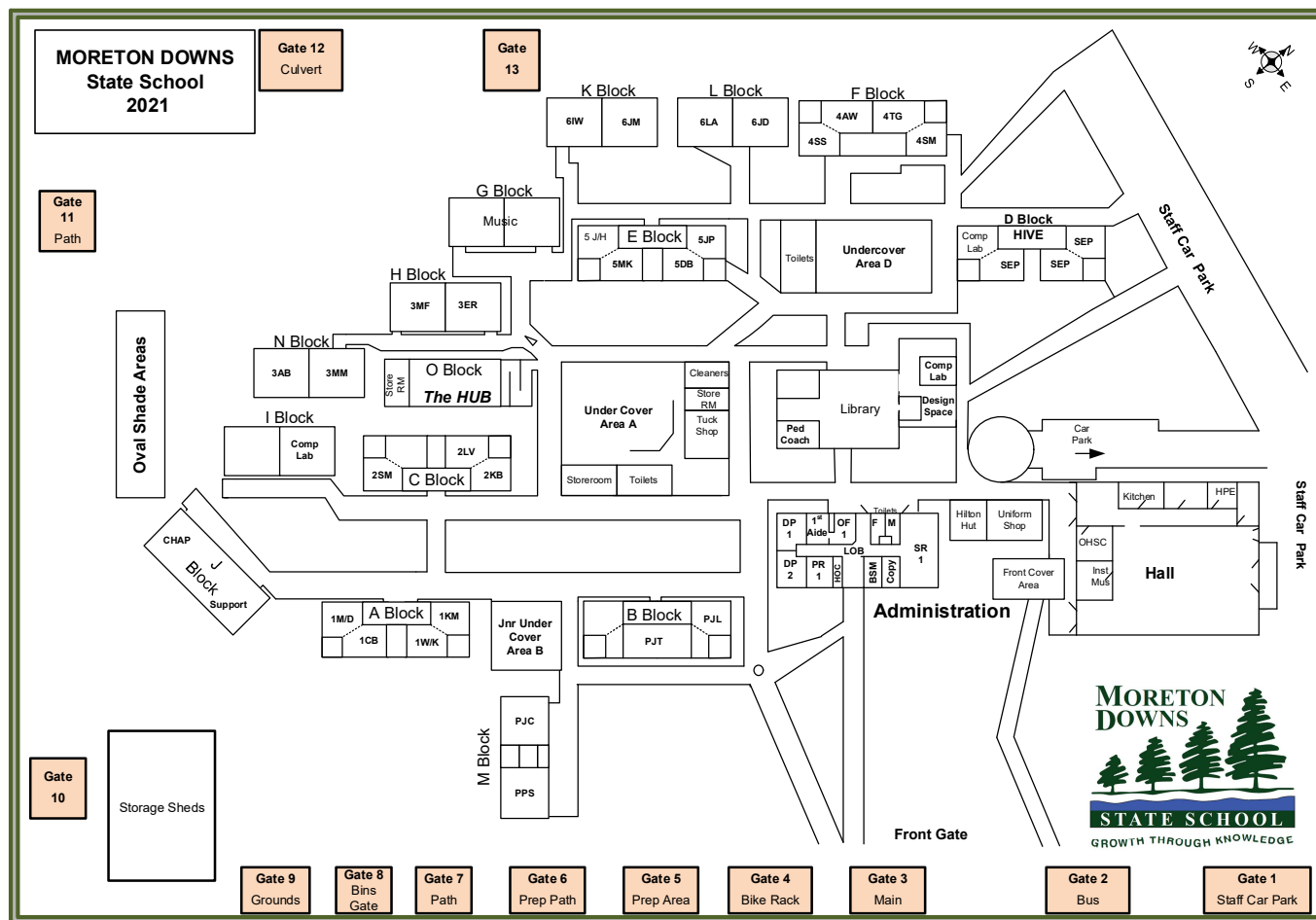


## Book drop off

Hope everyone had an enjoyable Christmas Break and a refreshing start to 2021. To alleviate some of the congestion on the first day back to school on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

A parent or carer with children in Years 1-6 will be able to drop off their child's books to their classroom from **2:10pm – 3:00pm on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021**. Please see below map of the school.



There will be a limited number of parents or carers allowed within the classroom at any one time (1 person per 4m square). Face masks must be worn when entering the classroom to comply with the current Covid-19 restrictions. Children under 12 years and people affected by a medical condition or disability do not lawfully have to wear a face mask.

Please remember to socially distance while waiting to go into the classroom. Parents or carers will need to sign into their child's classroom.

The Teacher will let parents know where to leave the books. A gentle reminder that you should deposit the books as directed by the teacher and then make your way out of the classroom to allow others to enter.

**The State Government recommends you wear a mask when outdoors if you are unable to stay more than 1.5m distance from other people, such as on busy walkways and thoroughfares.**

However, things may change and you will be advised of these changes as soon as possible.
